**\* History Department AP Policy as of 19 April 2007:**

AP scores of 4 & 5 on the American History or the World History test will be awarded 6 sem. Hours of history credit at Aquinas College.  
If the student subsequently takes a course for which he/she received AP credit, the AP will be removed from the record.

Starting Fall 2014 - A score of "3" is no longer acceptable for transfer in any history AP.

**No more than 6 hours of AP credit can be applied toward fulfilling the history major or minor.**

AP credit hours in history above the 6-hour threshold can be used toward elective requirements for graduation.

**\*\*English Department AP Policy as of 8 June 2007:**

If a student scores a 3 on AP English Lang, he/she will receive credit for EH 100; If the score is 4, 5, credit will be given for GE 101; If a student scores a 3 on AP English Literature, he/she will receive credit for EH 115 Underst/Apprec Literature; if the score is 4 or 5, and the student has not already received credit for GE 101, then they may be awarded GE 101 credit.  
If the student has 4 or 5 on BOTH AP English Lang and AP English Lit, credit will be given for GE 101 and EH 115. (EH115 changed from EH112 as of Fall 2014)
