Academic Drop Dates (Last day to drop a course from the transcript record with no academic penalty.)

First Quad Class: Friday, September 13, 2019

Financial Drop Dates (Last day to drop a course with no financial penalty, including the No Show fee.)

First Quad Class: Friday, August 30, 2019
 Semester Long Class: Friday, August 30, 2019
 Second Quad Class: Friday, November 1, 2019

No-Show Policy and \$150.00 Fee

Students who do not officially drop a class within the initial add/drop period, and are administratively dropped from a class because of non-attendance, will be assessed a fee of \$150.00 per class. There will be no charge for students officially dropping a class within the Financial Drop Dates. NOTE: *Responsibility for registration, add, and drop rests with the student. Instructors and advisors are not are not responsible for notifying the Registrar's Office of student registration changes.*

Graduation

Students who intend to graduate in December of 2019, May of 2020, or August of 2020 must complete an Application for Degree and submit it to the School of Education at least a semester in advance of the intended graduation date. There is one Commencement ceremony per year, in May.
