

DISCLOSURE OF GRADUATE LEVEL GRADUATION/COMPLETION RATES

Aquinas College is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. In accordance with federal reporting guidelines, the rates reflect the graduation/completion status of students who enrolled during the specified year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed.
